Todos los niños que están inscritos en las clases de Comunión o Confirmación deben asistir a misa. Aquellos en la confirmación deben registrarse después de la misa.

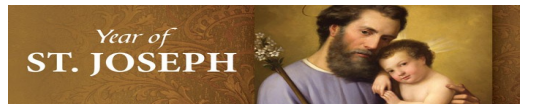
