Holy Mass of Obligation

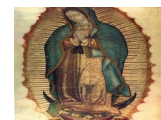
Immaculate Conception

Due to Covid-19 we will not be having an Angel Tree at St. Joseph church this year.

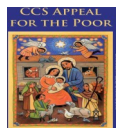
Social Action will be making a donation to New Way Ministries this year instead.

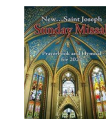
