St. Joseph Coffee hour returns this Sunday, March 13th! Join us!

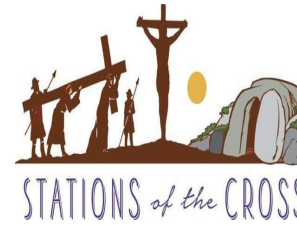
