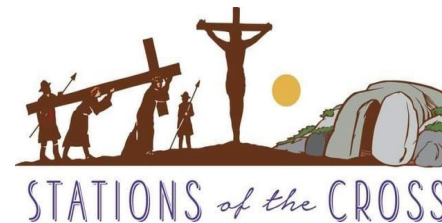


Support Agape Food Bank with Mini Golf!
