A Virtual Interfaith Music Festival and Celebration of Interfaith Congregations

The Interfaith Coalition Music Festival has been an annual highlight for many years. Kevin Allen-Schmid, who has directed the festival in previous years, created a musical film instead of holding an in-person festival. This 42-minute film features photos and music from all 41 member congregations of Interfaith Coalition – an historic first. The grand finale is a virtual choir, featuring 57 singers from congregations across Whatcom County and beyond.

We are thrilled to highlight *St. Joseph Catholic Church and St. Peter Mission* and our other congregations in this film. You have been part of Interfaith's work to help vulnerable Whatcom County children and adults - originally, in gaining access to medical care for all, and now in helping them escape poverty and homelessness.
