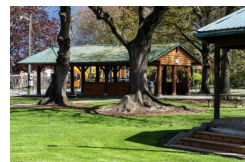

**Does someone have a grill they can bring to the park?**

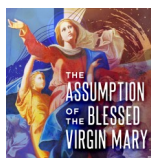
Families are asked to bring a dish per your last name as follows:
