Register your children now for faith formation for the 2021-2022 school year. Our Faith Formation Coordinator Olivia will be taking registrations on Saturday and Sunday masses on August 21st, 22nd, 28th, and 29th. The cost per student is \$30, which will cover books and supplies. After August 30th, the cost of registration will rise to \$35 dollars. Be sure to get those registrations in early, they can be given to Olivia, or they can be dropped off at the office. **Classes will begin September 26th** and run until May 1st. Classes are open to students aged 4-18. We look forward to seeing them in the classroom.

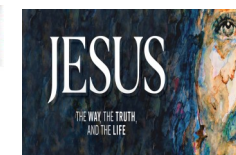
