Faith Formation Registration

Register your children now for faith formation for the 2021-2022 school year.

Our Faith Formation Coordinator Olivia will be taking registrations on Saturday and Sunday masses on August 28th, and 29th as well as September 4th, 5th, 11th, 12th, 18th, and 19th. The cost per student is \$30, which will cover books and supplies however, **after August 30th, the cost of registration will rise to \$35 dollars.** Enrollment will be closed on September 20th, and no late registrants will be taken after that. Be sure to get those registrations in early, they can be given to Olivia, or they can be dropped off at the office. Classes will begin September 26th and run until May 1st. Classes are open to students aged 4-18. We look forward to seeing them in the classroom.



Rite of Christian Initiation for Adult (RCIA)

Registrations are now open for the 2021-2022 calendar year. RCIA is available to those who have not been baptized in the Catholic church, those who have been baptized in a Christian church but are wanting to become Catholic, or those who have been baptized in the Catholic church but have not received the sacraments of confirmation, or communion. This program is wonderful for inquiring minds who wish to know more about the Catholic church. We will have both English and Spanish RCIA classes. 
Family Faith Formation Classes

This year we are introducing a new program for parents with children who are enrolled in faith formation classes. These classes seek to help strengthen the domestic church within the home by helping parents become stronger catechists for their children. These meetings will take place on the first Thursday of every month and will meet at 7pm. Classes will be offered in both English and Spanish. Registrations are due by September 20th. These meetings are required for parents who have their children enrolled in Holy Communion (first and second) and Confirmation. It is strongly encouraged for parents who have children enrolled in other faith formation classes. Classes are free.
