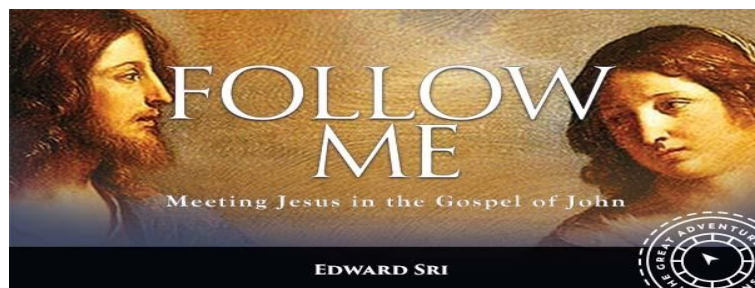
The Bazaar this year was a big success. Thanks to all that made it happen.
