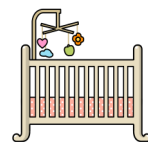

**PREPARES**

is the pro-life/social justice initiative of the Bishops of Washington state, launched three years ago, to come along side single parents and families with children under 5 years of age. The goal is to have an active PREPARES team in each Parish statewide, and St. Joseph's / St. Peter's is one of nearly half started so far. Our second annual "Crib Drive" for lent will begin next Sunday Feb 25th and continue through Wednesday March 14th. Donations of new or like new baby and children's clothing in sizes up to those fitting five-year old's as well as diapers in all sizes, baby items, books, small positively themed toys and cash donations to "even out" the bags, are all needed. As last year, the crib will be located outside the Parish office. This is very convenient for parents dropping off and picking up their children from Religious Ed. classes.
