Assumption students participate in the MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) standardized assessment three times per year. Based on these results, the teachers set goals with students in the areas of reading, math, language, and science, in order to track progress over the course of the school year. The assessment does compare student groups to the national norms in those grade levels, and Assumption students typically score in the 65th to 70th percentile in all subject areas. This year, the students scored highest during the fall assessment in the areas of language and science.
