Interfaith Coalition Family Promise Program

Our parish has committed to be a support congregation for Family Promise of Whatcom County. Family Promise is a 30-year-old National outreach program that Interfaith Coalition has brought to our community to assist homeless children and their families. Currently we have over 1400 children in Whatcom County (53 in Lynden) experiencing homelessness. Father Francisco and the Pastoral Council have endorsed this program as part of our social Action Program. Another congregation in Lynden, Cross Point Church, will be housing the families. We will work with them to help provide a few meals, volunteers to stay overnight, fellowship with families, and child supervision for a few hours one evening a week four times per year. Individuals, couples, families, grandparents, and teens are invited to participate. We need your help. Sign-up forms are at the parish office. 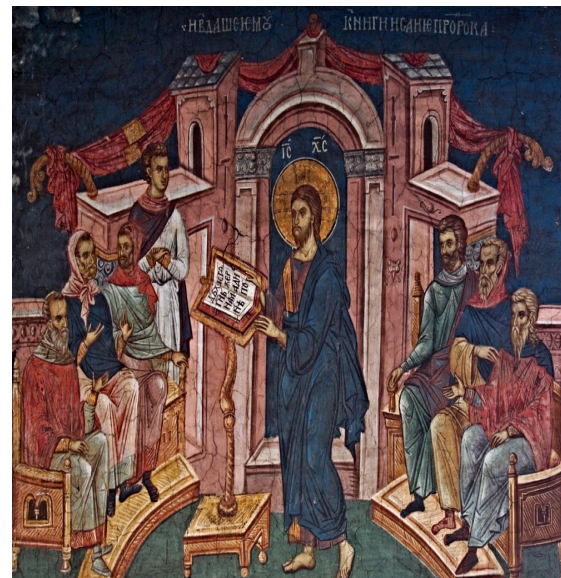

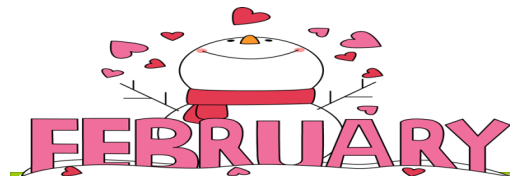

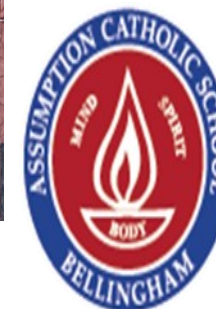
