Dear Church friends,

We, Kevin and Mary Reese, are very blessed to be able to tell you of our upcoming missionary trip. God has been merciful and has answered our prayers to be sent where He can use us the most. The monks of Westminster Abbey in Mission, BC, Canada, operate the Seminary of Christ the King, a

seminary of the Archdiocese of Vancouver, for the education and formation of priests. It is the principal apostolic work of the monks. In the fall of 2018, the Seminary will begin a new program called a Spirituality Year, sometimes referred to as a propaedeutic period, for all candidates who enter the seminary, where the students acquire basic human and spiritual formation prior to their formal education in philosophy and theology.

We will serve as a volunteer Benedictine Oblate Couple extending the Benedictine values, to the students with whom we will serve as missionaries. Our religious presence as Benedictine Oblate Missionaries, and most importantly as a married couple, will further enrich the seminary as the monks form and educate future priests. We, as Oblates, are recognized by Catholic Church law as associated with religious orders such as monasteries through the public promises we have made.

The purpose of the Spirituality Year is to help seminarians form a priestly heart, in the atmosphere of a Christian community, which involves acquiring a solid foundation for their faith, a habit of prayer, and a deep personal love for the Word of God; this time of formation also allows candidates to embrace their Christian priestly vocation and greater freedom of heart. With Pope Francis’ most recent guidelines for the training of future priests, the Church now considers programs like the Spirituality Year to be a regular part of seminary formation. We ask for your prayers for God’s grace and guidance as we serve at Westminster Abbey as a Benedictine Oblate missionary couple. 


Threshing Bee 2018
