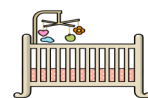
Will be hosting a Mexican Dinner Fundraiser, more details to come in future bulletins.

Assumption School Announcement

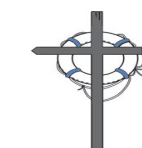
