A Note to our Parishioners,

It is important that we all try to arrive at Mass on time or hopefully even a bit early. We would especially ask those who have signed up for either an A group or B group please come early so we know you will be in attendance. Additionally, it really helps if you know you will not be coming to let us know in advance.



If you come to Mass and have not signed up for that Mass time but hope to have a seat we will do every thing possible to find you a spot. The Necessity to seat persons in proper spacing given the Covid restrictions make it a more involved task than during usual times.

Additionally, now that the basement is open for Mass attendance with good audio-visual equipment we are expecting a greater number of parish members to attend our weekend services.

We will attempt to seat as many persons upstairs as possible but after the beginning of Mass those who arrive a bit late will be asked to take a seat downstairs using the back stairway. This will avoid unnecessary interruption in the Mass and still provide a good way to experience it while social distancing.

An Extraordinary minister of Holy Communion will bring communion to the persons in the basement. After Mass those in the basement will be asked to exit the basement out of the entrance connected to the ramp on the west end.

We realize, as happened last weekend, that if you unfortunately arrive late and expected to be seated upstairs it is possible and likely that you will be asked to go downstairs. We of course will take into account any health reasons that cause someone to avoid stairways.
