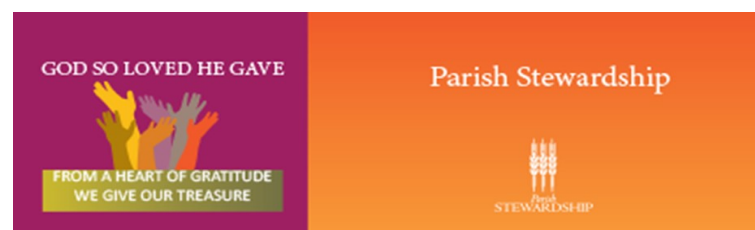

**Bazaar Meeting**

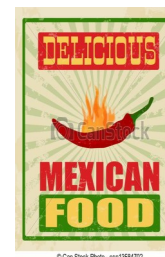

**Assumption Catholic School**

What is *Support for a Century* and the Assumption Catholic School Foundation? Each year, October marks the beginning of our *Support for a Century* campaign and promotion of the School Foundation. Last year the Foundation's goal was \$100,000 and thanks to a \$50,000 donation, a \$30,000 pledge, and multiple generous contributions, the *Support for a Century* campaign brought in \$131,000. In the past, donations have been designated for: current school operations and technology, tuition assistance, or for building the school's endowment which has grown to over \$500,000 since its inception in 2005. An endowment, as you may know, is meant to build into the future and therefore only a 4% average of that balance is spent in the current year.
