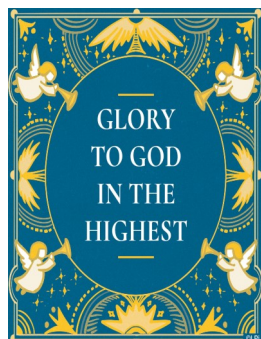


New Year Prayer:

Your generosity helped provide dinners to four homeless families (10 adults and 12 children. Your willingness to help those in need is truly inspirational and a blessing to all of us.

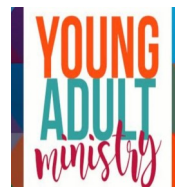
