**We now have a QR code for the pledge form, simply scan and it will direct you to the form:**



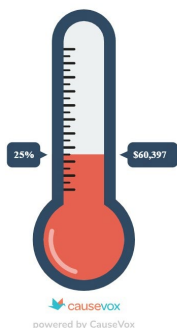
